

Budget Workshop

May 6, 2022

The Board of Aldermen/Alderwomen for the Town of Fremont, NC held a Budget Workshop at 5:30 p.m. on May 6, 2022. Present were:

Also in attendance were Town Administrator Tony Howell, Town Clerk Shannon Daly, and Finance Officer Cathy Nichols.

Those not in attendance were Alderman Leroy Ruffin.

Mayor Flowers stated that the purpose of the workshop is to discuss the budget for 2022/2023. He asked Mr. Howell to speak about the budget.

Mr. Howell went over the proposed budget expenses, as well as, the proposed revenues. There was much discussion about the proposed budget cuts and how well the budget is looking for next fiscal year. There also was discussion about the funds that are left in this year's budget and how those funds will be used. It was determined that some of the funds will be used for projects and maintenance. Those include, the tile at Hillandale, repairs to the roof and windows in Town Hall, repairs to two HVAC units in the Board Room and Police Department and to cover the expense for the development of the Land Use Plan. Also, it was determined that the Town will purchase a jumping tamp tool, rock, plumbing and electrical supplies and transformers for the Public Works Department.
